

| Pay social contributions for employees | Applying for European Health Insurance Card (EHIC) |
| Declare corporate tax | Claim a pension |

- Establish a technical system for the automated exchange of evidence between competent authorities in different MS

Directives on public procurement, professional qualifications and services


- Exception: procedures established at EU level providing for different mechanisms for the exchange of evidence

The single digital gateway, incorporating OOP in legislation

- Automated and in real-time
- Applies to evidence available in an electronic format that allows automated exchange
- Data protection:
 - explicit request
 - preview

Preparatory work

- 2019: High level architecture for the once-only system
- 2020: Work packages working with MS on technical and operational specifications




Next steps

- 2020: Deliverables from the work packages

- June 2021: Implementing act

- 2023: Once-only system in place for all procedures in the SDG scope
